The U-Multirank project which is undertaken by the CHERPA network has developed a multi-dimensional global university ranking which was first published in May 2014. The results of the previous phases can be found at www.umultirank.org.

One of the major aims of this ranking is to give information to future students helping them to make an informed choice on their university/higher education institution on an international scale.

Students' judgements on their own institution and programme play an important role in informing prospective students. Therefore we ask for your opinion on several aspects on the conditions and quality of your studies.

Taking part in the survey is optional and anonymous. The password for the questionnaire is derived randomly, there is no connection to your person. The necessary information for accessing the questionnaire was distributed by your university. Data is used only for the U-Multirank project.

Filling in the questionnaire will take about twenty minutes time.

Why do we collect and use your data

The U-Multirank web-tool is user-driven and both valuable for benchmarking between higher education institutions and for students seeking advice on where to study. Since the opinion of students is essential for the decision of the students, this survey asks students for their opinion about their studies.

U-Multirank does not collect personal data from students, unless explicitly and independently provided for the purposes of staying informed on U-Multirank results, developments and/or news. The invitations to the student survey are sent out by the participating universities. For this purpose, U-Multirank provides the contact person for the student survey with all the necessary documents (sample invitation letters, password lists). Participation in the student survey is anonymous. The password for access to the online survey is randomly assigned by the universities and does not allow U-Multirank to draw any conclusions about the participant. In addition, no personal data is recorded in the student questionnaire. The raw data of the student survey will not be passed on to the universities. Thus, the participating university cannot relate the data to its students (for example, no results on the indicators of the student survey will be shown if less than 15 students submitted their questionnaire).
